Do GMOs Cause Cancer?

She has a degree in Biochemistry and Microbiology from Universiti Putra Malaysia, Masters in Biotechnology and PhD in science communication from University of Malaya. Maha won the 2010 Third World Academy of Science Regional Prize for Public Understanding of Science for East, Southeast Asia and Pacific Region.



Cancer is the most terrifying and feared disease. The American Cancer Society says that there are “many possible causes” for cancer and provides comprehensive list of established and anticipated cancer-causing agents. And GMOs are not in any of these lists. GM crops were first introduced commercially in 1996 and to date it has been part of trillions of meals with not a single reported health hazard.



However, the foods from GM technology are often shunned by general public due to lack of knowledge about the technology and also the misinformation spread by NGOs. How are these crops and foods developed, are they safe, are they tested, how natural is the non-GM food that we eat?

This talk will attempt to address the above questions and give some basic understanding of GM technology and foods.
