Theme : Holistic Healing For Lung Cancer

Lung cancer is a disease characterized by uncontrolled cell growth in the tissues of the lung. If left untreated, this growth can spread beyond the lung through a process called metastasis into nearby tissues and, eventually, into other parts of the body. Most cancers that start in the lung, known as primary lung cancers, are carcinomas that derive from epithelial cells.

The main types of lung cancer are small-cell lung carcinoma (SCLC), also called oat cell cancer, and non-small-cell lung carcinoma (NSCLC). The most common cause of lung cancer is long-term exposure to tobacco smoke which causes 80-90% of lung cancers. Non Smokers account for 10-15% of lung cancer cases, and these cases are often attributed to a combination of genetic factors, radon gas, asbestos and air pollution including secondhand smoke. The most common symptoms are coughing (including coughing up blood), weight loss and shortness of breath.
