In 1961, she became the Life President of the Society by virtue of the Society's Ordinance No. 15 of 1957 following the demise of the Founder-President of the Society, H.H. Swami Satyananda PhD, J.P. Swamiji had been her inspiration and mentor throughout her life since the age of 11.

Mother Mangalam has received 29 awards from religious, social and political organizations, clubs, societies locally and overseas and also National Awards. The latest being Merdeka Award 2010 for community and education.
