Cancer: Integrative Approach – Challenges and Possibilities

DR. AMIR FARID ISAHAK [MBBS (Queensland, Australia), MMED (Singapore), MRCOG (London)] is a senior medical consultant with 40 years of medical practice. Although specialized in Obstetrics & Gynecology, he also practices aesthetics, anti-aging and regenerative medicine. In Malaysia, he is one of the pioneers practising Holistic Integrative Medicine - combining modern, natural, nutritional and complementary therapies as well as a pioneer of anti-aging and regenerative medicine. He was among the earliest to practise cell therapy, including stem cell transplantation. He is a popular speaker on Anti-Aging, Aesthetics, Nutrition, Wellness, Women's Health, Stress Management, Cancer and Qigong, having been invited to speak on these subjects by many organizations, companies and government departments; and at local and international health, medical and scientific conferences. He also conducts health and wellness seminars, courses, workshops and retreats.



Cancer Integrative Approach-Ayurvedic Perspective

DR. RAMKUMAR KUTTY hails from a traditional Ayurveda family. Since completing his formal Ayurveda education in 1991 from the Ayurveda College, Coimbatore, he has continuously been occupied in education and strengthening Ayurveda, the primary health tradition in India. He is the Founder Director of Punarnava Ayurveda, an institution committed to Authentic Ayurveda for Universal Well-Being, with the primary objective of "creation and sustenance of health for the global community in a cost-effective manner through Ayurveda and other traditional medical knowledge systems". Dr. Ramkumar has also been the prime mover behind a series of International Conferences on "Ayurveda & Yoga - where science meets consciousness". The first such conference was held in Mahabalipuram in 2006, the second in Rishikesh in 2008 and the third held in Rishikesh in February 2011.



Getting the best out of Integrative Treatment of Ovarian Cancer

DR. VIJAENDREH SUBRAMANIAM (Dr. Vijae) is a Senior Consultant Gynae Oncologist at Mahkota Medical Center, a leading private hospital in Malaysia. He graduated from the University of Malaya and commenced postgraduate training in Obstetrics and Gynaecology (O&G) in 1991, working at Raigmore Hospital (NHS) in Scotland. He gained a postgraduate qualification in O&G from the Royal College Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (RCOG, UK) in 1994. In 2003 he furthered his sub-speciality training in Gynae-Oncology in the UK at the St. Bartholomew Hospital (St. Barts), one of the leading cancer centres in London. Dr. Vijae is an accomplished surgeon trained in Minimally Invasive Surgery (MIS) in gynaecological cancers from the world-famous Kurashiki Medical Centre in Japan. Dr. Vijae has worked in oncology since 1995. Since 2011 he has expanded his practice areas to include alternative and complementary modalities in an integrative fashion in cancer treatment. He has travelled extensively throughout the world, learning and observing firsthand from leading practitioners of integrative medicine. He believes that the best results in cancer treatments are only possible by integrating the best of conventional therapy and complementary/alternative therapies.



Cancer Integrative Approach – Killing Cancer by Stem Cells

DR. CHRISTINE GONZALEZ is a born naturalist with more than twenty five years of practice, research and education in Natural, Integrative and Functional Medicine/Nutrition. Before setting up the Wellness Institute, in Manila in 2001, she practiced in her two clinics in Silicon Valley, California. Dr. Christine maintains clients in the US, Canada, New Zealand, Guam, Australia, Hong Kong, Singapore, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Sweden and Spain. Dr. Christine's work has leaned more and more towards the treatment of chronic diseases, especially cancer and auto-immune diseases. Early in 2008, the need for a solution to the current worldwide cancer crisis led her to dedicate her life towards cancer prevention and control through health education. In the same year, she opened a disease prevention facility in Lourdes, France and continues to lecture worldwide on "Prevention, Management and Control of Cancer" and other chronic diseases.



Cancer Integrative Approach – Role of Natural Medicine Psychosomatic Aspects of Cancer

MR. LOTHAR HIRNEISE has been chairman of Krebs21, an association that investigates non-university cancer therapies, for over 20 years. He travels the world to find out how cancer is treated in other countries and how successful these therapies are. His specialty is researching therapies that people have made to get healthy, even though conventional doctors told them there was no help anymore. He is also the only student of the well-known researcher Dr. Johanna Budwig (inventor of the Oil-Protein Diet and the famous Budwig - Protocol) and former research director of the National Foundation for Alternative Medicine in Washington D.C. Since 2006, he has been sharing his knowledge worldwide at lectures and in Germany at his 3E-Centre.



Happiness – Influence on Cancer

PROF. DR. SURESH KUMAR currently serves as a Professor of Parasitology and member of the UM Senate, Faculty of Medicine, University Malaya with a strong research interest on emerging protozoan infections. Has published more than 160 papers including conference papers and supervised more than 85 research students including at the level of PhD. He has established more than 9 research international collaboration and served as WHO Steering committee member in World Water Guidelines, Zoonosis and water, Shellfish and water since 2002. Has won several awards including National Young Scientist Award – 1996, the Toray Science Grant -1995, Chartered membership to Institute of Biology which carried the title CBiol, MIBiol -1999, Commonwealth Scholarship -2000, Golden Innovative award -2001, Golden Innovative Award at Annual MINDS 2002, Gold Medal at International Innovation Exhibition at Geneva 2002, MSPTM medal for outstanding contribution to the field of Parasitology and Tropical Medicine 2002, National Innovation award by MAMPU - 2003 and winner of Toray Award, 2008. Also serves as the Deputy President of the Sathya Sai Central Council of Malaysia.
